

Every student enrolled in a tested grade in an Oklahoma Public school must participate in either the OCCT (Oklahoma Core Curriculum Tests) general assessment with or without accommodations, the OMAAP (Oklahoma Modified Alternate Assessment Program).

Grades third through the eighth have standards-based criterion-referenced tests and are administered during April and May. Fifth grade and Eighth grade are also required to take a writing test. This test is administered in a one-day testing window in February. Students are directed to write an essay from a selected prompt.

The standards-based criterion-referenced EOI (End of Instruction) tests are administered four times a year. The completion of these tests is a requirement for high school graduation. Beginning with the freshman class of 2008-2009, the students are required to pass:

ACE(Achieving Classroom Excellence) English II,

ACE Algebra I,

and any two of the following :

- Biology I
- English III
- Algebra II
- Geometry
- US History

Students who don't score at least a "Satisfactory" score on any EOI test will be provided remediation and the opportunity to retake the test until at least a "Satisfactory" score is attained on the tests of Algebra I, English II, and two of the tests required or an approved alternate test.

Students scoring "Limited Knowledge" or "Unsatisfactory" on Grades Seventh and Eighth reading and/or math EOI tests or Algebra 1 EOI tests shall be offered the opportunity for remediation.

Remediation may be provided by extended time during the school day, tutoring, online coursework, or other supplementary services. Waurika Public Schools provides before and after-school teacher instruction, Study Island and Work-Keys, two online tutorials.

It is Waurika Public Schools policy to mail test scores to parents. Also, parents of students who scored below "Satisfactory" will receive a remediation letter letting them know when they can send their child for remediation. If your child needs remediation, please contact Mrs. Latimer at the Counselor's Office.
